

NO SINFUL CONCENTRATION OF POWER

One of the beauties of the Christian Confederation Period, in contrast to this modern Neo-Babylonian Empire Period, of US history is the way power was not amassed and concentrated but diffused and spread among the sovereign States. There will always be people who are hungry to amass more power than is healthy for themselves or the nation as a whole, but there needs to be strong hedges preventing such. During the Christian Confederation Period, there was no powerful Executive or powerful tenured Federal Supreme Court mandating for the nation, and backed up by the power to tax and dictate orders to all of the states and localities of the USA.
